Using expensive and radical procedures like surgery leads to an increase in addiction to opioids and fails in up to 47% of the cases to eliminate pain.

Using acupuncture first dramatically lessens the need for surgery and the reliance on strong pain - relieving medications.

It make sense to utilize other less invasive and less costly treatments first!



Numerous studies show that surgery fails

1st Study - "Failed Back Surgery Syndrome: A Review Article"

The overall failure rate of lumbar spine surgeries: 10%–46%.


Conclusion: The number of patients developing Failed Back Surgery Syndrome (FBSS) can be expected to increase continuously.

Conclusion: Lumbar fusion for the diagnoses of disc degeneration, disc herniation, and/or radiculopathy in a WC setting is associated with significant <u>increase</u> in disability, opiate use, prolonged work loss, and poor RTW (return to work) status.



3rd - Overtreating Chronic Back Pain: Time to Back Off?

629% increase in Medicare expenditures for epidural steroid injections.

423% increase in expenditures for opioids for back pain.
307% increase in the number of lumbar magnetic resonance.
images among Medicare beneficiaries.
220% increase in spinal fusion surgery rates.

Conclusion: These increases have not been accompanied by population-level improvements in patient outcomes or disability rates.



Time to Back Off? epidural steroid




For every 48 patients prescribed a new opioid in the emergency department 1 will become a long-term user (from the VA)

Vermont Study

Here's what they found:

- People received about 8 acupuncture treatments in 60 days.
- More than half (57%) felt better and needed less of pain-relieving medicines (non-opioid). About one-third (32%) who took opioids for pain needed less of it.
- Many people with jobs (74%) said they could do their work better after acupuncture.
- Almost everyone (96%) said they would recommend acupuncture to their friends who have long-lasting pain.
- Also, 91% of patients felt better in different ways like moving better (physical), doing things better (functional/behavioral), and feeling better emotionally (psycho-emotional).
- So, the study shows that acupuncture helped a lot of people feel better in different ways, and they liked it!

Integrated Chronic Pain Program (ICPP) in Rhode Island used different methods like massage, acupuncture, and chiropractic care to help 345 patients.

- ER Visits went down by 61%.
- Prescription medication use went down by 63%, and for strong pain medicine (opioids), it went down a lot more, by 86%!
- Pain levels went down by 42%.
- The program didn't just help people feel better; it also saved money. The cost for medical care for each person in a year went down by 27%. And for every dollar spent on the program, they saved \$2.41 in medical expenses! That's like getting more for your money.

Does Acupuncture Treatment Affect Utilization of Other Hospital Services at an Urban Safety-Net Hospital?

After an average of 7–9 treatments the largest average decrease in total charges was \$8,967.24

Conclusion: These data, coupled with strong support for the therapeutic efficacy of acupuncture, suggest that **the addition of acupuncture may have positive economic results for hospitals**, especially urban safety-net hospitals, and therefore for patients and insurance companies.
