The Governor's Appointment Office is currently accepting applications for seats on the Florida Board of Acupuncture. The Board was legislatively established to ensure that every acupuncturist practicing in this state meets minimum requirements for safe practice. The Board is responsible for licensing, monitoring, disciplining, and educating acupuncturists to assure competency and safety to practice in Florida.

The Florida Board of Acupuncture plays a leading role in the ever-changing health care environment through dialogue with the public, the legislature, and the community. The Board consists of seven members appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate. Five members of the board must be licensed acupuncturists. Two members of the board shall be laypersons. Please forward this information to your colleagues who you believe would be interested in applying.
